# **Decorating at Green Lawn**

- The cleanup of temporary decorations occurs regularly during the mowing season and after holidays. Please ask the office if you have questions about permanent vs. temporary decoration or about what is permitted on your lot.
- Only grass may cover a grave.
- Glass vases, bottles, stone chips, fencing, edging material, shepherd hooks, toys, ornaments, and other potentially dangerous items are prohibited.
- Lighted and battery-powered decorations are not permitted.
- Do not release balloons on cemetery grounds or leave balloons on a lot.

- Flush-marker lots cannot accommodate permanent adornments
- Visitors may plant flowers only on a monument lot. Flowers may not intrude on another lot. Trees and shrubs may be planted on a lot only with prior approval from the office.
- Please refer to the complete planting policy in the office before you plant. Plantings that do not conform to the planting policy will be removed.
- Please open a work order at the office to request the seeding of a lot.

The complete decorating policy, planting policy, and cemetery regulations are available in the office. These policies and regulations help us keep Green Lawn Cemetery beautiful and safe for visitors and employees. Please contact the office if you have any questions regarding your lot.

Grounds may close for winter storms, flooding, high winds, lightning, and other unsafe weather. We apologize for any inconvenience, but we value your safety.
